Scott Caul is a long-time, dedicated home brewer and is deeply involved in his local community, especially as it relates to supporting and promoting brewing. With a deep base in home brewing and with the goal of opening a brewery, the Siebel Concise Course will offer Scott the technical foundation to transition from home brewing to commercial-scale brewing systems and processes.
